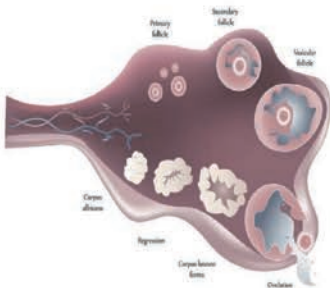

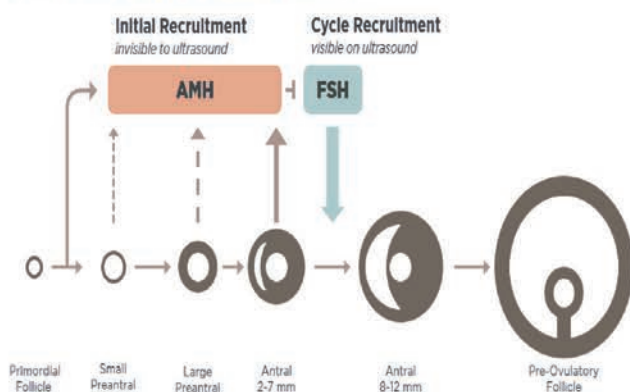


Anti-Mullerian hormone (AMH),

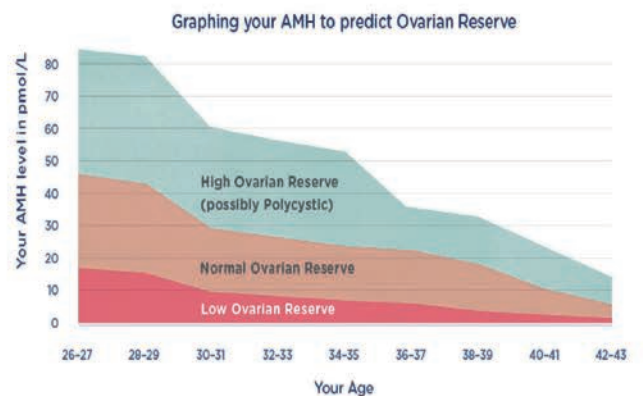
Anti-Mullerian hormone (AMH) is one of the best indicators of the number of eggs in your ovaries, or your ovarian reserve. AMH is produced by granulosa cells in your ovarian follicles – meaning the tiny sacs in your ovaries that house and release eggs.

Function of AMH

AMH is Secreted by Early Growing Follicles

What does a low AMH level mean?

Low AMH means that you have a low ovarian reserve, but it doesn't mean that you are unable to conceive naturally. Unfortunately, there are no proven ways to increase your AMH levels. Although, some research has shown that vitamin D and DHEA may help increase AMH levels.
